☀ Our History

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul, an international organization devoted to serving the poor, was founded in Paris in 1835 by a young French student, Frederick Ozanam. Founded locally in 1964, SVdP has served the needy in Contra Costa County through its conferences, social services and thrift stores.

☀ The Conferences

Our community-based service locations, called conferences, are located throughout Contra Costa County to provide help and support to the needy and discouraged.

☀ Our Volunteers

Our network of more than 1,000 volunteers, known as Vincentians, are key to the success of SVdP in providing help to people in their local communities and leadership for our programs. Our volunteers also work at our Family Resource Center in Pittsburg.

☀ Our Thrift Stores

Our thrift stores provide free and low-cost clothing, housewares, and furniture to the poor. Revenues from our stores provide a critical source of revenue for administration and services provided by our safety net programs.

Dining Room

St. Vincent de Paul partners with Loaves & Fishes of Contra Costa County to provide a free, hot meal to the hungry every weekday.



Food Pantry

St. Vincent de Paul partners with the Food Bank of Contra Costa and Solano, restaurants, and supermarkets to provide emergency groceries to individuals and families in need every weekday.

Health and Wellness

St. Vincent de Paul works in partnership with RotaCare Bay Area to provide quality medical care to uninsured adults with acute or chronic medical conditions.



Workforce Development

The Workforce Development program provides training, mentoring and work experience for those who are new to or have been out of the workforce to help them find long-term work at a decent wage.

Daytime Shelter

Recognizing a growing need for respite during the day, St. Vincent de Paul, in partnership with Winter Nights Shelter, provides a daytime refuge for homeless families seeking relief from the streets.

Case Management

St. Vincent de Paul partners with Catholic Charities of the East Bay to provide immigration and rental housing assistance.
